- 8. Financing Agriculture and Agribusiness
- 9. Policy Environment for Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security

Abstract Format

Each abstract should not be more than 250 words. It should illustrate research

motivation, objectives, outcomes, and the impact of the project in brief and bear

the following details.

Guidelines for Poster Submission

Posters should capture the visual representation of the project, highlighting some

of the achievements in detail. The submitted posters will be reviewed, and

exhibition spaces will be provided for the most successful posters. Accepted

posters will be prominently displayed within the event venue featuring a

dedicated poster session to facilitate lively discussions among the presenters and

delegates.

Posters should concisely elucidate the research questions being addressed and

their significance to sustainable agriculture and food security.

Recommended Poster Format

The Title: A short concise title

Abstract (Description): Give a short description of your research project.

Purpose/Objective/Goal: What was the intent or goal of the research project?

What did you want to solve and learn?

Background: What was the problem and why was it important? What knowledge

are you building on?

Methods: What was the design? What was the data? What tools were used? How was the data collected and analyzed?

Results and Discussions: What were the findings? Were they impactful to society and/or academia?

Conclusions: What is the overarching lesson to be learned from the findings?

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Please follow the guidelines below to ensure your poster meets the required format and quality standards:

General Requirements

- Orientation: Posters must be in portrait orientation.
- Dimensions: Maximum size is 90 cm (width) x 120 cm (height) or A0 format.
- E-Poster Format: E-posters must be submitted as a PDF file in portrait orientation.
- It is recommended that posters be prepared on one sheet of material.

Design Specifications

- Font Types: Use one of the following fonts: Arial, Calibri, Verdana, Times New Roman, or Helvetica.
- **Font Size:** Minimum font size should be **12 points** for readability.
- Images and Tables: Must be at least 200 dpi to ensure good visual quality.
- **Inserting Visuals:** Please **copy and paste** images, photos, tables, etc., directly into the document. **Do not embed** other files or documents.

The provided information on the posters must be authentic and evidence-based.

Submission Deadline: 18th July 2025.

Successful applicants will be notified by 1st August 2025
